Have you received your E-rate funding?

Did you know, since 2015, all applicants who submitted an eligible and timely E-rate application will receive their funding? Many schools have not taken full advantage of their entire Category Two budget, often leaving available funding unrequested. Don't leave money on the table — apply now.

What is E-rate?

The Universal Service Schools and Libraries Program — commonly known as the E-rate program — provides discounts on telecom, internet access, and internal connections to eligible schools and libraries.

How is E-rate funded?

E-rate is funded through the Universal Service Fund (USF).

Who leads/administrates the E-rate program?

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) writes the rules and standards for this program. The administrator of the E-rate program is the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).

What kind of discount can my school get?

E-rate discounts range from 20–90% of eligible project costs. Discounts are district wide, and an applicant's discount rate is determined by the percentage of students that qualify for a free or reduced-price lunch.

How do I choose a service provider?

E-rate applicants must conduct a fair and open competitive bidding process. All applicants must select the most cost-effective service provider. The price of the eligible products and services must be the most heavily weighted bid evaluation factor.

What can you tell me about the five-year C2 funding cycle?

The FCC's Category Two Report and Order (FCC 19–117) established the rules, C2 budget multipliers, and the funding floor for the fixed, five-year funding cycles. The C2 budget multipliers and the funding floor for each five-year funding cycle are set once at the beginning of the cycle and apply to the entire cycle. The first five-year C2 budget funding cycle began in FY2021 and runs through FY2025.

Why should I apply for E-rate funding this year?

Funding Year 2025 is the last year of this Category Two budget funding cycle. Any C2 budget remaining, does not roll-over to the next funding cycle beginning in 2026. So, this year is truly a "use it or lose it" funding year.

How do I apply for E-rate funding?

To apply for E-rate funding, simply follow the 6-step process outlined in Figure 1. Click on each box to learn more about the various steps in the process.




Figure 2. HPE Aruba Networking E-rate eligibility tool
